



Class Philosophy

The classes at Mudworks are designed to provide you with specific skills in clay work while making sure you have a great time. We have overall class projects or

objectives that will satisfy the experienced clay artist. We also modify the projects to fit the needs of any clay newbie! You are encouraged to bring your ideas to class and we'll discuss how you might make them happen. A relaxed learning experience is our goal.

Wheel

Experienced This class is for those who want to build on existing skills and throw more complicated forms. You should be able to throw a 6" cylinder, bowl form and plate form, pull and attach a handle, trim and glaze. Class Fee: \$210

Novice This is for those new to the wheel or wish to refresh their throwing skills. We will work with the basic forms of cylinder, bowl and plate and take your skills to the next level. Class Fee: \$210

Handbuilding

This is a great class for those who have little or no experience with clay. We'll explore a variety of handbuilding techniques and incorporate some surface treatments using stamps, underglaze, slip, and glaze. Class Fee: \$210

Sculpture

For those who wish to experience sculpting in clay. Bring your idea for a sculpture and we will make it a reality. Class Fee: \$210

Kids 'N' Clay

An after-school clay experience for children 8 years of age and older. Each child will have an opportunity to work on the wheel, sculpt, and glaze their work. The \$140 fee covers materials, equipment, clay, glaze and use of tools. *Adult takes the class with the child for only \$95!*

Friday Night Clay Fest!!

Those with prior clay experience are invited to join us for an Open Clay night. Each person will work on his or her own projects (wheel or handbuilding) Demonstrations and assistance always available! A great way to start your weekend! Expand your clay skills in a relaxed atmosphere! Class Fee \$ 35 per night, clay not included.

Open Studio

Enrolled students are encouraged to attend Open Studio nights. The studio is available for students to work on existing projects or create new items. No new instruction is available. No additional fee; this is included in your class fee.
